Middle School

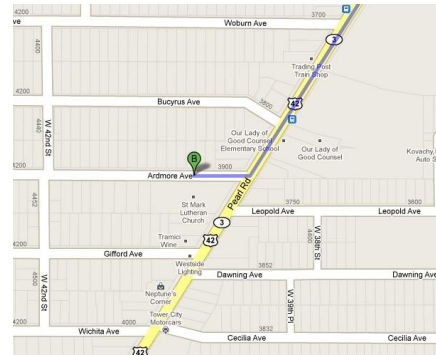

CREATIVE

Luther Memorial is proud to be an arts focused school. At LMS we feel it is important to incorporate the arts into the daily lives of our students and to help them realize the importance of their God given talents. Many times a student who is struggling with academics may find he or she can excel in the arts. Currently we offer several arts focused programs:

String Orchestra—LMS offers both beginning and advanced string orchestra. We have an artist in residence who conducts both of the orchestral programs, along with a Saturday morning community honors orchestra program.



Art—We have an art teacher who comes to our school each week to provide amazing art instruction to all of our students.

Dance— We are blessed to have an artist in residence who provides weekly dance instruction for our students.

Choir— Choir members rehearse both sacred and secular works. All of our performance based groups have opportunities to share their God-given talents with churches and other organizations. Visiting the home churches of our families is a blessing!

CLASSICAL

Luther Memorial is very unique in our “classical” approach to education. In addition to core subjects, we also include a focus on phonics, grammar, history and Latin taught from a Christian world-view.

We often hear the question, “Why teach Latin?” At LMS we believe that teaching Latin will help to prepare our students for high school and college. Over fifty percent of the English language comes from Latin. Learning Latin helps our students to better understand vocabulary and grammar.
